There is still more : Footprints of the sacred

As you walk around, you may see the white stone pillar that were introduced at No.38 (*Saifukuji* temple), No.45(*Zenshoji* temple), and No.53(*Anyoin* temple) standing on the side of the road.

Looking at the surface of the stone pillar, letters such as 「會八十八」 are engraved. There stone pillars are also one of the guideposts of 88 sacred sites, and can be confirmed in various parts of the city along the road with 88 sacred sites.

Do you feel romance when you realize that stone pillars that you normally pass by casually are actually telling the history?
